La Marseillaise Op. 20 for orchestra, chorus and soloists (1989).

Commissioned by the University of Hull for the bicentenary of the French Revolution. It was originally performed with strings, a brass quintet, two pianos and organ, and later arranged for full orchestra. The composer has no objection to its being performed with just one soloist, transposing the solos an octave up or down as appropriate.

Derek B. Scott was born in Birmingham in 1950. He graduated from the University of Hull with first class honours in Music and went on to study with Anthony Hedges for an M.Mus. in Composition. He was awarded a PhD in the sociology and aesthetics of music in 1991. He was Head of the Department of Music, then Professor of Music, at the University of Salford 1993–2006, and Professor of Critical Musicology at the University of Leeds 2006–2020.
