The drones on the CD are played by Rhodri Davies using e-bows on the low strings of the harp. They were recorded by Graham Halliwell at his studio in Norfolk and edited onto CD by Andrew Poppy at Arrowfrac in London.



Notes for Performance


The harpist plays at a dynamic level just above the pre-recorded drones on the CD. These drones must be clearly audible but not too obtrusive. The player should be seated in between the two speakers from the CD player and should use a digital stopwatch synchronised with the digital display on the CD player, or should be able to clearly see the digital display when performing.
